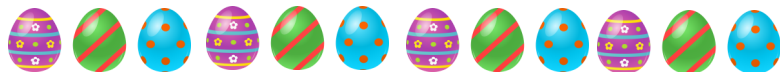
FROM THE HEAD OF CARE
