Our residents' bedrooms are their own private place and we encourage residents and families to make this their own space. Many residents bring in pictures and even their own furniture to make their room truly homely. Residents' own rooms have ensuite facilities, many with walk in showers, all rooms are equipped with emergency call facilities and personal television and telephone points if required. All our rooms are easily accessible with easy wheelchair access throughout the building and with lift access for those on the first floor.



Myers Lounge

This is the largest of our lounges, where many of our activities, including visiting musicians and our popular morning exercise classes take place. The room is finished beautifully and has an open gas fire, widescreen television and piano where residents can relax over a movie or enjoy the view of the gardens. There is a library in the Myers Lounge and we supply magazines and papers in the lounge area.



Sun Lounge

A great open space where residents meet for a variety of activities, including the ever-popular knitting club, this space is also used by friends and families when visiting residents. In this area we also have free use of a computer for residents' use.



Garden Room

No surprises here but a great place to sit and take in the garden all year round, even on those cold and dreary days. The room is also home to a partnership project that we are very proud of from The Wallace Collection, a National Museum in London. We have been working with on a new innovative project called The out of the frame loan boxes. It is aimed at giving older people in care home settings outside of London, access to the collection. We are given a different loan box every month of different themes. They are full of reproduction images of portraits.
